Cardiovascular Core: Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring

CHPS provides 24-hour ambulatory blood pressure monitoring (ABPM) using Spacelabs Healthcare equipment. The service is provided by experienced nephrology physician and nursing staff who will coordinate the visit and place the monitor, instruct the subject/families, upload the data, prepare study reports and perform other necessary tasks. Interpretation of results will also be available.

The All studies using the CHPS CV Core require IRB and CHPS approval before CHPS services can be provided or study visits are scheduled.

3. Please note, OnCore is a requirement of the Research Institute and is not administered by CHPS.
