



CHILDREN WITH A SCHEDULED KIDNEY TRANSPLANT BIOPSY ARE NEEDED FOR A RESEARCH STUDY

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

Kidney biopsies are used to diagnose complications in kidney transplant patients, but this method is invasive and can have limited results. We are studying if non-invasive imaging methods like an MRI and ultrasound can help diagnose complications without a biopsy.

WHO CAN BE A PART OF THIS STUDY?

Any individual 6 years or older with a scheduled kidney transplant biopsy.

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS BE ASKED TO DO?

Complete 4-6 study visits, each lasting about 2-3 hours, at CHOP within 48 hours of your scheduled kidney biopsy to complete a:

- · Physical exam and interview
- Blood draw
- MRI scan of the abdomen
- Ultrasound with contrast (optional)
