



## PEOPLE WITH ARPKD ARE NEEDED FOR A CARDIOVASCULAR RESEARCH STUDY

### WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

The primary goal of this research study is to learn if patients with autosomal recessive polycystic kidney disease (ARPKD) are at risk for brain aneurysms or cardiovascular abnormalities.

### WHO CAN BE A PART OF THIS STUDY?

Any individual 6 years or older with ARPKD.

### WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS BE ASKED TO DO?

Make a single 4-5 hour visit at CHOP to complete a:

- Physical exam and interview
- Blood draw
- MRI scan of the brain (no contrast or sedation)
- Non-invasive heart and blood vessel measurements, including echocardiogram

You will also be given a 24-hour blood pressure monitor to complete at home and return via prepaid mailer.

### WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE IN THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

You will receive compensation for your participation.
