WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

The purpose of this research study is to learn about autistic teens' experiences with repetitive behaviors. We will take MRIs of some participants to see what areas of the brain are associated with autistic teens' experiences with different types of repetitive behaviors.

WHO CAN BE A PART OF THIS STUDY?

This study is open to autistic teens between 13-17 years old and a parent or caregiver.

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS BE ASKED TO DO?

We want to learn about your experiences with repetitive behaviors! Do your repetitive behaviors bring you enjoyment? Do your repetitive behaviors help you relax? Are there things you don't like about your repetitive behaviors? We seek your help to answer these important questions.

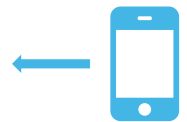
